Toledo, OH..... Discounted early bird registration for the 2016 Mercy Health Glass City Marathon taking place **Sunday, April 24, 2016 will end December 31, 2015.** Race participants are encouraged to register early to ensure that they secure their spot in this 40th anniversary race.
